Transformation in Minutes


Transform your customer's radiator in just 5 minutes with a new front panel. It fits straight onto the existing radiator with no drilling, gluing or screwing required.

Attaching the Panels

- Required Equipment: Adjustable spanner, wooden board, rubber hammer, utility knife, and decorative panel. Optional Equipment for purchase: Side panels, thermostatic head, and/or top grill.
- 2. Remove the existing TRV from the radiator and place to the side.
- 3. Using a rubber hammer force the end panels to shuft up and out of their locked positions. Carefully remove end panels from the radiator and place to a side.
- 4. With the end panels removed, the grill can be removed from the radiator and place to the side.
- 5. Fit the supplied retaining clips over the top lip of the front radiator panel.





















- 6. Space magnets at each end and in the middle of the radiator onto the front radiator panel inside the ribs.
- 7. Place the grill back into place on top of the radiator over the retaining clips.
- 8. Refit both end panels sliding down into place to lock on the grill.
- 9. Hand the decorative panel over the top retaining clips.
- 10. Adjust the decorative panel to ensure it is squarely fitted on the radiator.
- 11. Fit the lower retaining clips onto the lip at the bottom of the decorative panel.
- 12. Press the bottom of the decorative panel up against the radiator and fold the lower clips over the bottom lip of the radiators front panel.
- 13. Refit the TRV to the radiator.
- 14. Decorative panel is now fitted and this process should take a maximum of 5 minutes to complete.
